

## Today at Children's Church!

Today at Children's church we talked about loving our neighbor as ourselves! Our Bible story was from Luke 10:25-37 – the Parable of the Good Samaritan. God wants us to love Him and to love the people He places in our lives – even those who may be hard to love. He wants us to help those in need and to show compassion to all.

So here is what we know today:

1. Jesus said, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind"; and, 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'"
2. God wants us to love Him and love the people He places in our lives – He wants us to help those in need.

Table Talk: Throughout the week, ask your child these questions to get faith conversations rolling at home!

1. What is one new thing you learned in Children's Church this week?
2. In the Parable of the Good Samaritan, how many people passed the injured man and didn't help?  
*(2, then the Samaritan stopped and helped)*
3. Who is your neighbor?  
*(anyone that needs help or compassion, the people God places in our lives, etc.)*

Weekly Challenge: This week, I encourage you to read Luke 10:25-37 with your kids. Help them brainstorm people in their lives who may need help and ways that they can show compassion! Then, try and help your kids follow through in helping their neighbor.
