

## Today at Children's Church!

Today at Children's church we talked about how God gives us everything we need and so much more! Our Bible story was from Luke 12:13-21 when Jesus shares the Parable of the Rich Fool. Jesus tells of a man who had so much grain, he ran out of room to store it all. So instead of sharing it with people in need, he chose to build a bigger barn so he could keep it all for himself. God gives us all that we need each day – even though we may not get everything that we want - He promises to take care of our needs no matter what! Then, because God gives us so much more than we need, He wants us to share what we have with those in need.

God gives us all we need and so much more – He wants us to share what He has given us with those in need.

Table Talk: Throughout the week, ask your child these questions to get faith conversations rolling at home!

1. What is one new thing you learned in Children's Church this week?
2. Tell me about the Bible story from this week! What do you remember from the story Jesus told?  
*(Jesus tells of a man who had so much grain, he ran out of room to store it all. So instead of sharing it with people in need, he chose to build a bigger barn so he could keep it all for himself.)*
3. Is it easy or hard to choose if something is what we need or what we want? Why or why not?

Weekly Challenge: This week, I encourage you to read Luke 12:13-21 with your kids. Talk about the difference between needs and wants, focusing on how God gives us everything we need and so much more! Then, together, pray that God would show you one way you can share what you have with someone in need.
